Education Code Section 60850






Current Practices

CAHSEE Requirements

- The CAHSEE was offered for the first time in spring 2001 (March and May) to volunteer ninth graders (class of 2004).
- Passing of CAHSEE became a diploma requirement for the Class of 2006
- All California public school students except eligible students with disabilities must satisfy the CAHSEE requirement,
- CAHSEE is used in calculating the Academic Performance Index (API) for state accountability and for Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) to meet federal No Child Left Behind







CAHSEE Senior Status 2006-2010

Seniors needing to pass CAHSEE

- **2006 = 40**
- **2007 = 40**
- **2008 = 34**
- **2009 = 25**
- **2010 = 34**
- 2010 March, May and July test results still need to be incorporated into this year's results
