Discussion of the Superintendent's Performance Pay Plan Goals

for the 2012/13 School Year

BACKGROUND: The Board implemented a performance pay plan for the Superintendent. The plan shall provide for an annual onetime payment, based on achievement of some or all of the established goals, of up to \$15,000.

Per the Superintendent's contract, there shall be three or four annual goals, all related to the District's Master Plan. Each year, the Superintendent and Board shall agree upon the number and content of the goals. Each goal shall represent an equal portion of the full \$15,000 payment. These goals are being discussed here.

At a public Board meeting in June of each year of the term of the Superintendent's contract, the Board and the Superintendent shall report the results of her performance plan goals for the next school year. The Board shall discuss the report and authorize payment to the Superintendent of a proportionate amount of \$15,000 for each goal that was achieved for the then current school year.

Next steps: At the October 25th public Board meeting the Board will be asked to approve the proposed goals. In June 2013 the Board will be asked to authorize payment for any or all of the successfully completed goals.

Proposed goals for 2012-2013 Superintendent will:

- Increase attendance by increasing percentage of students with 96% attendance by 3% as measured in June 2013.
- Increase District wide API by 9 points or more over 2011-2012 API school year (results available August 2012).
- Increase total percentage of students enrolled in at least one AP course by 2% as measured in September of 2012 enrollment.
