CTE State Enrollment Analysis

January 05, 2014

A review of CTE student enrollment data by DataQuest (DQ) reveals the following information. In the 15 CTE industry sectors, CTE lost 101,090 students in 2012-13 when compared to the 2011-12 school year. A summary of CTE data is as follows:

- * 11.8% CTE student enrollment decrease statewide
- * 38.1% of all students (grades 9-12) are enrolled in CTE courses
- * 11.1% decrease of CTE courses statewide
- * 19.6% decrease of FTE CTE teachers in Grades 9-12
- * 4 of the 15 Industry Sectors had increases in student enrollment compared to 2011-12 (Agriculture & Natural Resources, Art, Media & Entertainment, Health Careers, and Engineering & Design

Clearly, this data indicates a downward trend in students enrolled in CTE courses in California. The sectors that had the largest decreases were: Business & Finance (- 42.5%), Education, Child Development & Family Services (- 38.4%), Public Services (- 19.0%), Consumer & Family (- 15.4%), and Fashion & Interior Design (- 15.3%). The Sectors that had the greatest increases were: Engineering & Architecture (+ 13.9%), Art, Media & Entertainment (+ 7.7%), Health Science & Medical Technology (+ 5.7%), and Agriculture & Natural Resources (+ 2.2%).
